

in the Carniolan Provincial Museum, established in 1821. Here, you can discover the founding collections of this oldest Slovenian cultural and research institution: Baron Sigmund Zois's collection of minerals and Franz Hohenwart's collection of conches – both of great historic and scientific value. A part of the permanent exhibition are also the geological paleontological collection, a collection of freshwater fish, reptiles, birds, and skeletons of various vertebrates, as well as the Ferdinand J. Schmidt's collection of insects. The local wildlife of forests, marshes, and mountains is portrayed in dioramas.

Other than the permanent and temporary exhibitions, you can also enjoy in the interactive presentations, which ensure your stay at the museum will be an interesting experience, that ensure there is never a dull moment in the Slovenian Museum of Natural History.
